This summer a group of alumni and a few of the actives that were around the house renovated three rooms in our house. The laundry room, the first floor bathroom, and the dish room. The bathroom and dish rooms both required the removal of the old floor and both were discovered to have their joists cut into. It was evident most in the bathroom were the floor tended to sink if you stood over or around the toiled. Both rooms' support joists were reinforced with 2X10's, re-plumbed, insulated, covered with proper subfloors, and retiled. The Bathroom go a new faucet and toilet which is fat man approved and comfortable. The dish room got a new garbage disposal and sprayer head found in many professional kitchens, as well as additional tiles along the wall to help prevent water damage on the walls. Both rooms have since been sealed, floors, edges, and sinks, and are water tight. The laundry room wall was disintegrating from water damage/leakage from the brick behind it. The wall and rotting wood was removed and replaced by a vapor barrier, insulation and new framing. The drywall has been replaced, and is scheduled to be taped and puttied at the first work party. The weekend went very well and we got a lot accomplished thanks to some dedicated alumni. My thanks go to those that helped and donated so that we could continue improving our house.
