Fall 2013 - 4th with a 3.11

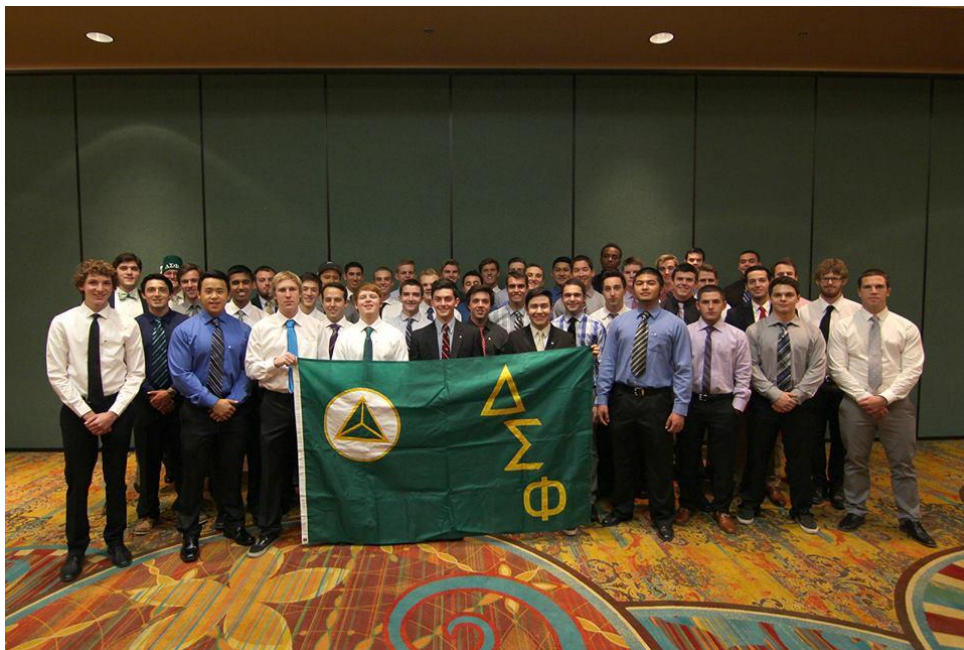
And don't you fret with a stellar senior class leaving we somehow found smart pledges / New Actives. Their Fall GPA was a 3.39.
